What are the common issues that need Brick repairs?

Cracking- There are different reasons for cracking along mortar joints such as foundation problems, a design flaw, deterioration, or settlement, or a combination of more than two issues.

Chimney- You should know that chimney is a self-supporting structure, but if the support fails in any way then the rest of the building will also be affected. A chimney is longer, stands taller, and has a thinner foundation compared to other structures. It should be fixed at the right time.

Leaning- When you experience that any part of your building is leaning inward or outward, it indicates something is wrong there. Do not delay to fix it.

Unsafe walls- It is another important condition that requires brick repairing immediately. Your building must stabilize no matter if it is a new property or an old one. A disconnected wall is barely reliable.

When do Brick repairs include the repointing method?

Brick repointing is one of the most important parts of brick repairing and it is essential for masonry structure. But you need to understand different reasons for using repointing. When we talk about the brickwork of a building, it is a visible part of your property and it also requires repoint or replacement.

Brickwork is not as solid and durable as it always looks. If you are ignoring proper treatment for a long time, then you are making a mistake. There are some indications you can find so that ensures that you need to fix it.

Different signs such as loose or weakened bricks or stone or mortar joints cracking or worsening, damp walls, or damaged plasterwork on the inside of masonry walls. Most often property owners assume that all these issues are naturally caused by weathering or from age-related failure. However, it may not be the case at all.



You should know that there are some other major issues you can count on in this case such as leaking roofs or gutters, foundation settlement of the building itself, indecorous mortar application, blocking moisture vents behind the masonry work producing humidity behind the masonry wall.

At the same time, another issue that causes damage is the harness of the original mortar mixture. In some cases, the mortar is harder than the brick or stone, the brick itself can begin to spall, crack, and fail like the mortar should have done initially. Sometimes, the mortar is supposed to breathe, flex, and is supposed to ultimately fail, so the brick will not be leaving the wall itself in decent basic form.

All these issues should be properly fixed. These are the root causes of and you need to take the right steps to repair and remove these issues. Else, the masonry unit worsening will continue and lead to damage to building components.

Step by step process of brick wall repairs or repointing-

Of course, repointing brick walls and chimneys with new mortar is not about improving their beauty, but it ensures their security. At certain times, when the mortar between bricks starts to damage, using the procedure of repair or Brick repointing is a smart decision. When the decaying mortar is left untreated, it enables water to seep in between the bricks and lead to swell and crack.

However, there are some of the basics you need to follow when repointing brick walls. All these stages are given briefly.

Elimination of the old mortar- When it comes to repointing, it is working in small sections. It doesn't need to eliminate all of the old mortar from a wall at once. You need to take away old mortar from both the horizontal and vertical joints to a depth of about 1/2 inch. You can use different types of tools for this task such as a cold chisel or handheld grout saw or a joint raker. Make sure you are doing it properly without damaging the brick wall's integrity. Then clean all the dust by using a whisk broom or hose and wear a respirator.

Put water on the Wall- After removing mortar, provide the brick wall a wet and leave it overnight so that the bricks and old mortar are hydrated well. So you can easily put the new mortar in the next day.

Blend the new mortar- It depends on your house age. If it is less than fifty years, you can simply use standard cement mortar. However, if it is older than that then you want to use a different mix, consisting of lime and sand. Do this task properly and make sure you are mistaking it. It doesn't matter which mortar mix you are using, you should make it in small batches as it hardens quickly. Remember, a mortar works best in temperatures between 50 and 80 degrees.

Supplement the new mortar- Take some mortar on a big trowel and place a smaller amount into the horizontal and vertical gaps between the bricks by using a pointing trowel.

Clean Up- Wait until the mortar has hardened a bit and then you can scrape off any mortar that remains on the brick face. Use a robust wire brush in a horizontal sweeping motion so the new mortar of the joints will not pull out. After this process, you ought to wait for 3-4 days and give the wall a daily misting so that the mortar will dry gradually with no crack.


