

Vice President of Compliance: How to Become a Compliance VP?

The chief compliance officer needs to be a law degree holder, MBA or an engineer with strong foundation skills. One can get certification from any institution to be Compliance VP. Skills Required for a Compliance Executive

➤ **Communication Skills**

He must be able to communicate with various internal divisions and also with clients. If required, he may also need to communicate with the board of directors for a better understanding of the policies and practices of the organization.

➤ **Decision-Making Skills**

A compliance executive must have good decision-making skills to make objective decisions in the best interest of a company's growth and reputation. In addition, he must be able to advise the manager on how decisions made could result in problems in the future.

➤ **Data Analysis Skills**

The compliance executive needs to know about technical security, privacy and data protection issues, as these are important factors that should be considered before implementing new policies or procedures.

A compliance executive is a person who must be able to analyze and evaluate many factors that could lead to security risks. He may also need to meet with the clients to maintain their satisfaction with the company's operations.
