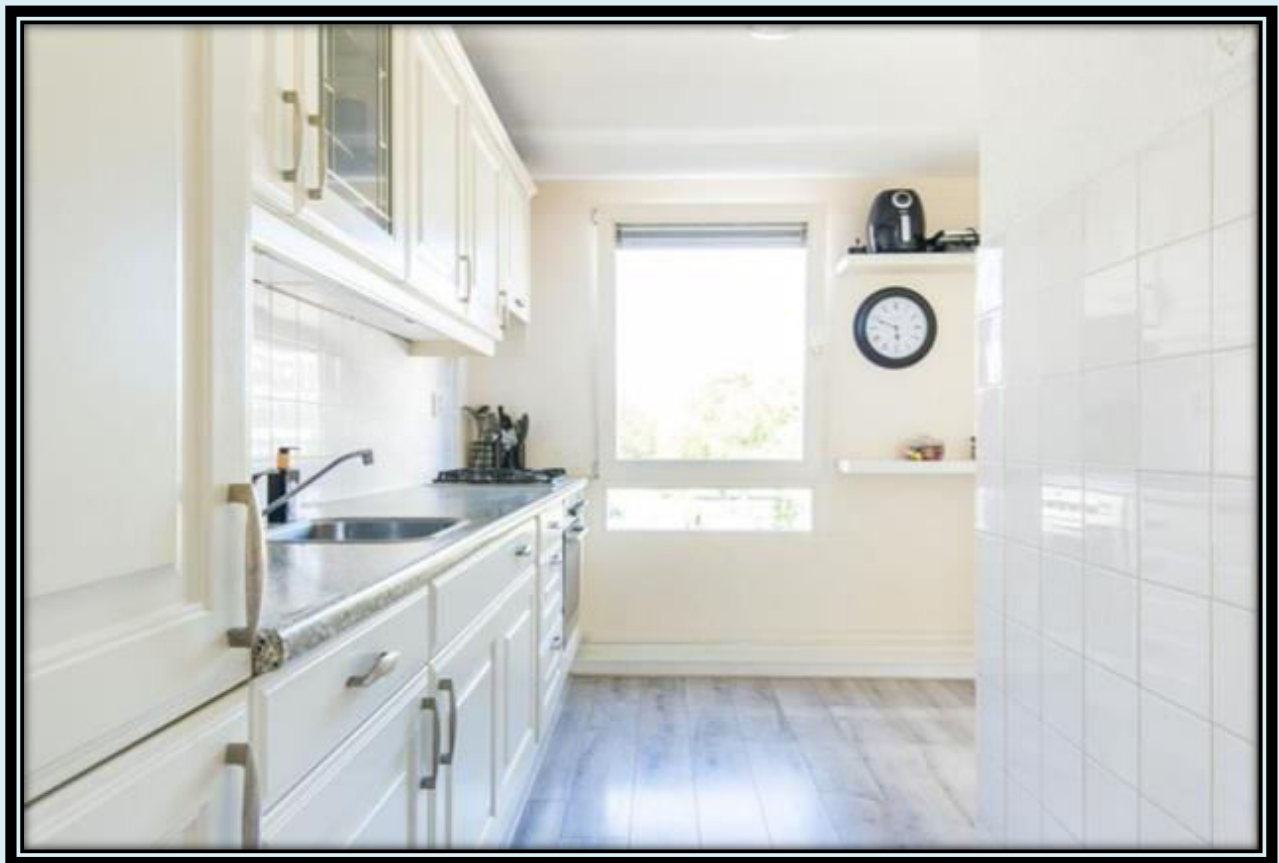




Things You Need To Take For Rent A Room in Amsterdam!
